Mobile phones:

There are two main ways to protect your mobile phones:

- Set your phone to vibrate or discreet, so you are not a target for phone thieves.
- Don't talk or txt when you are walking, so that you know what's going on around you.
- Only give your number to mates you trust, this will help stop unwanted texts and calls.
- Text or phone your parents/carers to let them know that you have arrived safely.
- In an emergency you can call 999 even if you have no credit.
- If your phone is stolen call 'Immobilise' on 08701 123123.
- You can call 100 in a phone box to reverse the charges, so if your phone is out of action you can still call home.

Second, make a note of these details and keep them somewhere safe:

- the IMEI number (this can be found on most phones by keying *#06# or by looking behind the battery)
- the phone number
- the make and model of the phone
- The phone's PIN number.

If someone steals your phone, you will have a better chance of getting it back if you can give the police these details.
