Remote learning support for individual pupils who are self-isolating	Plan A	A personalised programme of study will be put in place to ensure the pupil can keep up with what is being taught in school. Remote learning support for small groups of pupils who are self-isolating	Plan A	Those in the small group of pupils required to self-isolate for 10 days will be expected to follow their normal school timetables each day as closely as possible and complete activities and tasks set by their teachers. We will review their needs and the provision we make for them individually and as a group.	Lesson information will be available in MS Teams and Show my homework. Pupils who are self-isolating in these groups will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Find lesson materials, such as any PowerPoint presentations used by the teacher, resources and assignments in MS Teams;</li> <li>Access recommended websites and licenced software;</li> <li>Complete any tasks or assignments set for him/her and his/her peers in MS Teams and Show my homework;</li> <li>Attend live lessons in MS Teams, but only where there are common lessons and their normal class teachers are available because of their group's absence from school or where the school has made special arrangements.</li> </ul>	SLT, Year Leader, Heads of Faculty, Teachers	Weekly telephone call
Remote learning support for pupils in the event of a partial closure or rota model	Plan B	In the event of partial closure, and for the period of time pupils may be required to learn from home in a rota model, we will offer all pupils in the affected year groups access to live lessons in MS Teams where possible.	Parents and pupils will be advised of the provision for blended learning that we will make via our website and weekly e-newsletter. Lesson information will be available in MS Teams and Show my homework. Live lessons in MS Teams will be scheduled according to a revised timetable. Plan C	We will adjust our timetable to ensure all pupils learning at home attend a broad range of live lessons and a weekly session with their tutors in MS Teams. Provision for vulnerable children and young people and children of critical workers	Plan B and C	In the event of a partial closure, rota or lockdown, we will remain open only for vulnerable children and young people, including those with EHCPs, and the children of critical workers.	Vulnerable pupils and young people, including those with EHCPs and children of critical workers attending our on-site provision during a partial closure, rota model or lockdown, will be allocated to a year group or Key Stage 'bubble'. They will follow a timetable that provides access to blended learning. They will be supervised and supported. They will have the opportunity to participate in remote learning and live lessons alongside their peers.	SLT, Teachers, Teaching Assistants	Daily reviews and feedback
