

The Powell's Learning Centre (PLC) contains both a well-stocked Library with a good selection of books, magazines and DVDs, and a learning area equipped with 30 PCs. The PLC is a lively, safe space available to pupils during morning and lunchtime breaks and is open from 8.30 am to 4.25pm for reading, research and other activities.

During lunchtimes there are games such as chess and UNO available, and the option to join in with a reading club. There is also the opportunity to become a Librarian Technician and help keep the PLC organised and running efficiently.

When using the Library, we expect the pupils to behave responsibly and treat the space in accordance with the schools standards.

Books are issued by the Librarians with a 3 week return date issued at the front of the book. DVDs are available to hire on a 2 nightly basis for a small charge of 30p. Any borrowed items are taken out using the pupils' Smart Cards and will therefore remain their responsibility to look after them and return them promptly and in good condition.

Any overdue books or DVDs will be followed up with pupils via their Tutors. However, if any book or DVD is lost or badly damaged, a letter will be sent home asking for a replacement or payment to replace them.

We look forward to seeing lots of Year 7 pupils taking the opportunity to use the library as a useful learning resource that is available for them to access.
